Lakshmi Narayan Temple:

Popularly Known as Birsa Mandir it is a large hindu temple built in orissan architectural style, in 1938 by the renowned birsa family. The temple was inaugurated by Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi, on the condition that it will be open for people of all castes.

Qutub Minar:

Qutub minar is an excellent example of Afghan architecture. The minar is a 72.5 mts. High victory tower. The Construction of which began in the final year of 12th century by Qutub'd Din-Albak and was later completed by His successors.

Bahai's House of Worship:

Situated a top Kalkaji Hill. It is also known as "The Lotus Temple" due to its distinctive Lotus shaped design in marble. It was built in 1987 by the followers of Bahai's faith. The temple signifies the purity and equality of all religions. (Monday Closed).

Red Fort:

Built by Shahjahan, the builder of the Taj Mahal in Agra. The Construction lasted from 1639 to 1648.

The simple square platform of black marble marks the place where the father of nation, Mahatma Gandhi, was cremated. Earlier an ancient Ghat on the banks of River Yamuna was called Raj Ghat.



Humayun's Tomb:

Built by Humayun's widow, Queen Haji Begum in the 16th century, it is supposed to be a prototype of the Taj Mahal at Agra. Humayun's garden-tomb is also called the 'dormitory of the Mughals'

Amber Fort:

A magnificent Fort palace and the remains of the ancient City are the high spots. Other sights are several royal cenotaphs, Hindu & Jain Temples, Dilaram Gardens and archaeological Museum.

Jaipur Museum:

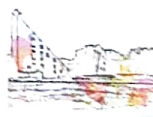

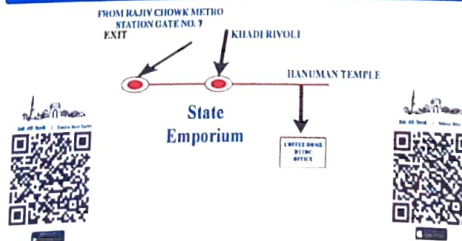
